

Privacy Policy and the use of cookies.

ConnectTo Global sp.z o.o. makes every effort to ensure that your privacy while using the resources of our website is protected. The privacy policy applies to services provided as part of our website. However, the rules established by their administrators apply to other websites, including those possibly linked by hyperlinks or otherwise with our website.

1. Personal Data Administrator.

1. The administrator of personal data is ConnectTo Global sp.z o.o. with headquarters in Bielsk Podlaski (hereinafter the "Administrator"), ul. 3 Maja 12, 17-100 Bielsk Podlaski, e-mail address: kontakt@connectto.pl

2. The privacy policy applies to all services provided by the Administrator as part of the website. The administrator applies procedures to prevent misuse or unauthorized disclosure of personal data. Only the Administrator and employees authorized by the Administrator have access to the personal data collected by the Administrator, who need it to provide the services offered.

3. The administrator collects the following personal data:

1) users of the Website, provided when ordering a commercial contact or provided for advisory purposes or for offer purposes, such as:

- first name and last name,
- e-mail address,
- Phone number,
- and other

2) The administrator may also process data about the user's computer, such as IP address, browser type, and (in the case of users using mobile devices) Unique Identification Number, operating system, application version and longitude / latitude only for the purposes of the service provided within the page.

3) collected when making transactions. If you want to log in on the website, we will ask you to provide the data necessary to finalize the login. The data may also be used to facilitate contact for purposes related to the implementation of the website's tasks and for marketing purposes. These will be data such as name, surname, correspondence address, e-mail address, telephone number, company name, tax identification number. You have the right to delete or change this data at any time, except for the data necessary for logging in and website tasks.

4) The administrator processes personal data for the purpose of:

- enabling logging in to the part intended for users with a login and password,

- sending information, newsletters and other commercial information in accordance with the terms of the Privacy Policy.

The Administrator reserves the right to send commercial information to the contracting entities of the products and services offered on the website. If commercial information is sent at the request of a third party, the shipment is carried out by the website administrators, and third parties do not gain access to the addressees' data.

The administrator transfers or discloses personal data to government institutions or law enforcement agencies, if it is necessary and necessary due to legal provisions, in accordance with the provisions of the Act on the Protection of Personal Data.

4. Personal data are processed for the purpose of logging in or the service provided by the website pursuant to art. 6 sec. 1 lit. b) GDPR; fulfillment of legal obligations incumbent on the Administrator resulting, for example, from tax law pursuant to art. 6 sec. 1 point c) GDPR as well as for marketing purposes and possible redress pursuant to art. 6 sec. 1 lit. f) GDPR, where actions performed in the legitimate interest of the administrator include the processing of personal data for direct marketing purposes and the Administrator's pursuit of possible claims from users.

Personal Data are processed only for a specific, explicit and legitimate purpose justified by the provision of individual services and are not processed in a manner inconsistent with these purposes. When processing personal data, the Administrator ensures that persons authorized to process Personal Data will undertake secrecy, and also takes all measures required under art. 32 GDPR.

The Administrator does not transfer Personal Data to countries outside the European Economic Area or to international organizations.

5. Each user who provides personal data to the Administrator has the right to access his personal data at any time, verify, delete or change his personal data. In order to make changes to personal data, please contact the Administrator at the following address: kontakt@connectto.pl

Providing Personal Data is voluntary, however, it is necessary to perform the tasks of the website in the part dedicated to logged in users.

The administrator has the right to change the method of collecting, transferring and processing personal data and other information at his own discretion, but only for purposes related to the provision of services on the website. In this case, the Administrator will modify the provisions and inform in an appropriate message on the website www.connectto.pl about the changes.

The administrator has the right to use the help of external service providers, including data administrators. Then these entities are treated as third parties and are subject to the Administrator's guidelines and the provisions of the Act on the protection of personal data.

2. Trademarks, trademarks and other graphic signs.

1. Registered trademarks, trademarks and other boundary markings identifying a given entity, owners' names and copyrighted text and images are generally not posted with an appropriate annotation on the page on their protection. However, the absence of this type of information

does not mean that these signs and data are for public use in the context of trademark law or copyright law.

3. Cookies

1. ConnectTo Global sp. Z o.o. uses cookies (so-called 'cookies'), which are data stored on the user's end device and intended for the use of the website. Cookies usually contain the name of the website they come from, the storage time on the end device and a unique number used to identify the browser from which the website is connected.

2. The website uses both session and permanent cookies - including: necessary cookies, enabling the use of services available on the website (e.g. authentication files), cookies used to ensure security (e.g. used to detect fraud in the field of authentication in within the website), performance cookies, enabling the collection of information on how to use websites, functional cookies, enabling the user to remember settings and personalizing the user interface, advertising cookies, enabling users to provide advertising content more tailored to their interests, web analysis cookies that collect information about how the website is used, the type of page from which users have been redirected, and the number of visits and duration of users' visits to the website.

3. The website may contain cookies of external entities such as: Google, YouTube.

4. The user may change the parameters of the web browser regarding cookies, however, limiting the use of cookies may affect some of the functionalities available on the website.
